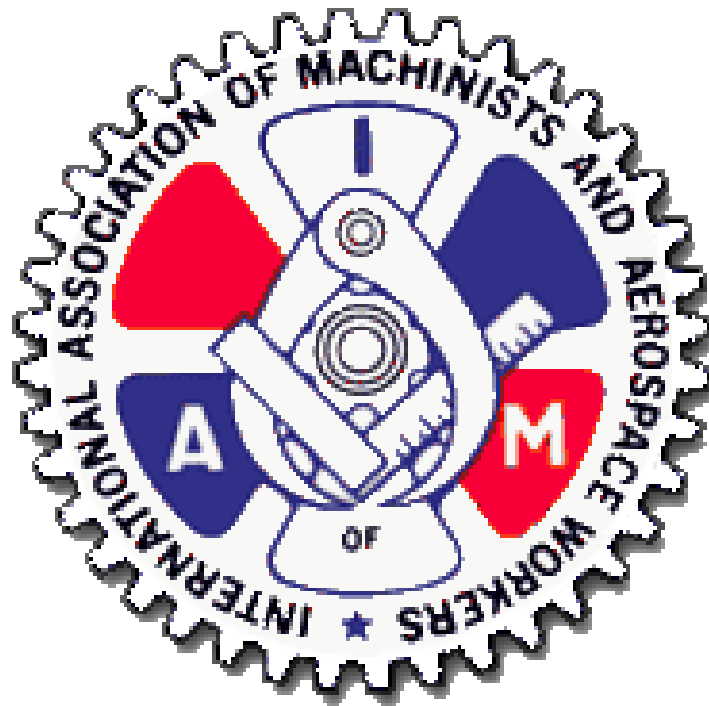


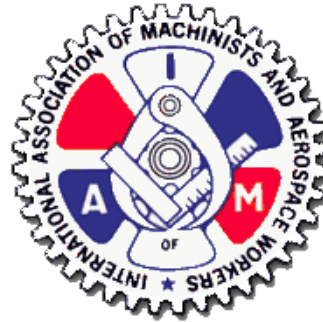
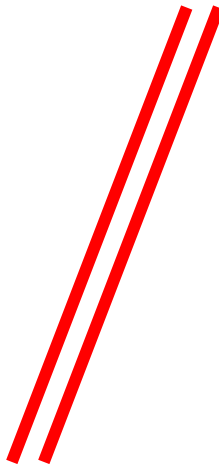

The Robert V. Jurasek Scholarship is named in honor of an instructor from the initial cadre of ATS instructors assigned to Little Rock Air Force Base in 1987. This beloved Navigator died of Liver Cancer in 1992 after a 20 year career as a true “Airlifter” in the mighty C-130 Hercules. It is our hope that his legacy will live on as we help others achieve their goals.

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded annually to a deserving high school senior who is legally related to any member in good standing of Chapter 463 of the International Association of the Machinists and Aerospace Workers Union. Children and step-children are eligible to receive this award.

A committee from “Hercules” Chapter 463 screens the applications and makes a recommendation to the Executive Committee. The scholarship is awarded at the June general membership meeting.

The winner will be notified in writing by the scholarship committee and informed when the presentation will be made. The scholarship check will be made out to the applicant.

The packet should be sealed, your name written on the front, and returned to Sharon Smith. Applications must be turned in no later than May 31 of the current year.
